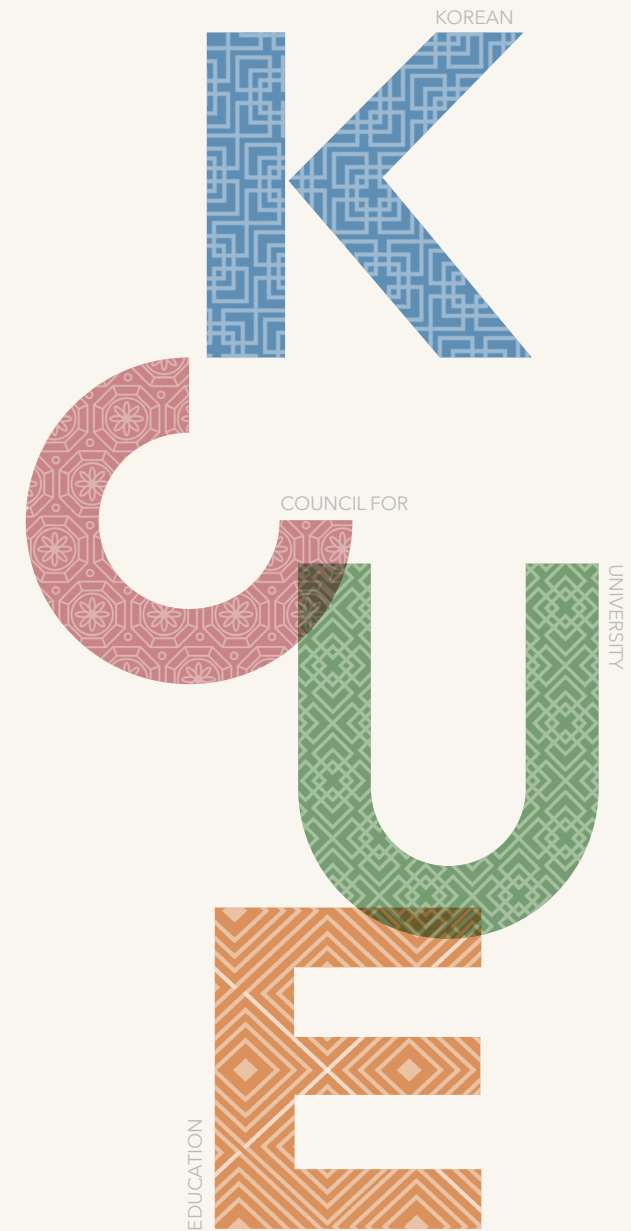

KCUE is putting an effort to lay the ground for the internationalization of higher education in Korea especially through curriculum and to promote cross-border mobility of students and faculties. KCUE also focuses on the role as a communication channel between the government and universities, as a facilitator and coordinator of discussions among member universities, and as an institution developing balanced and rational policies to advance higher education in Korea.

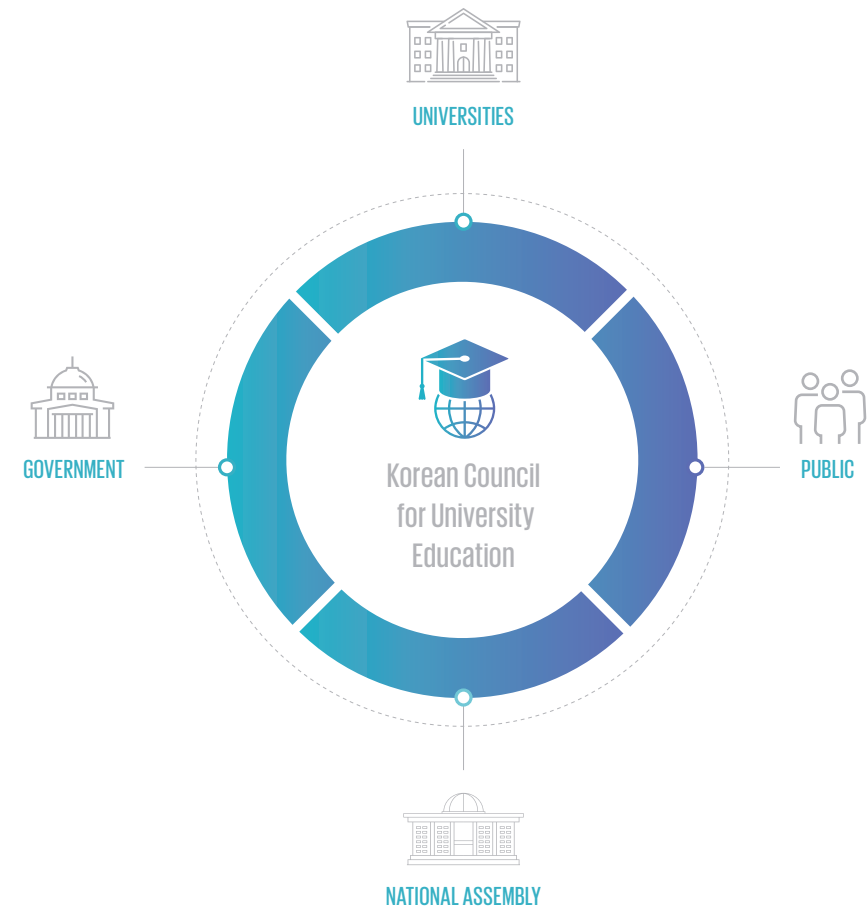

KCUE, the active channel of communication in higher education

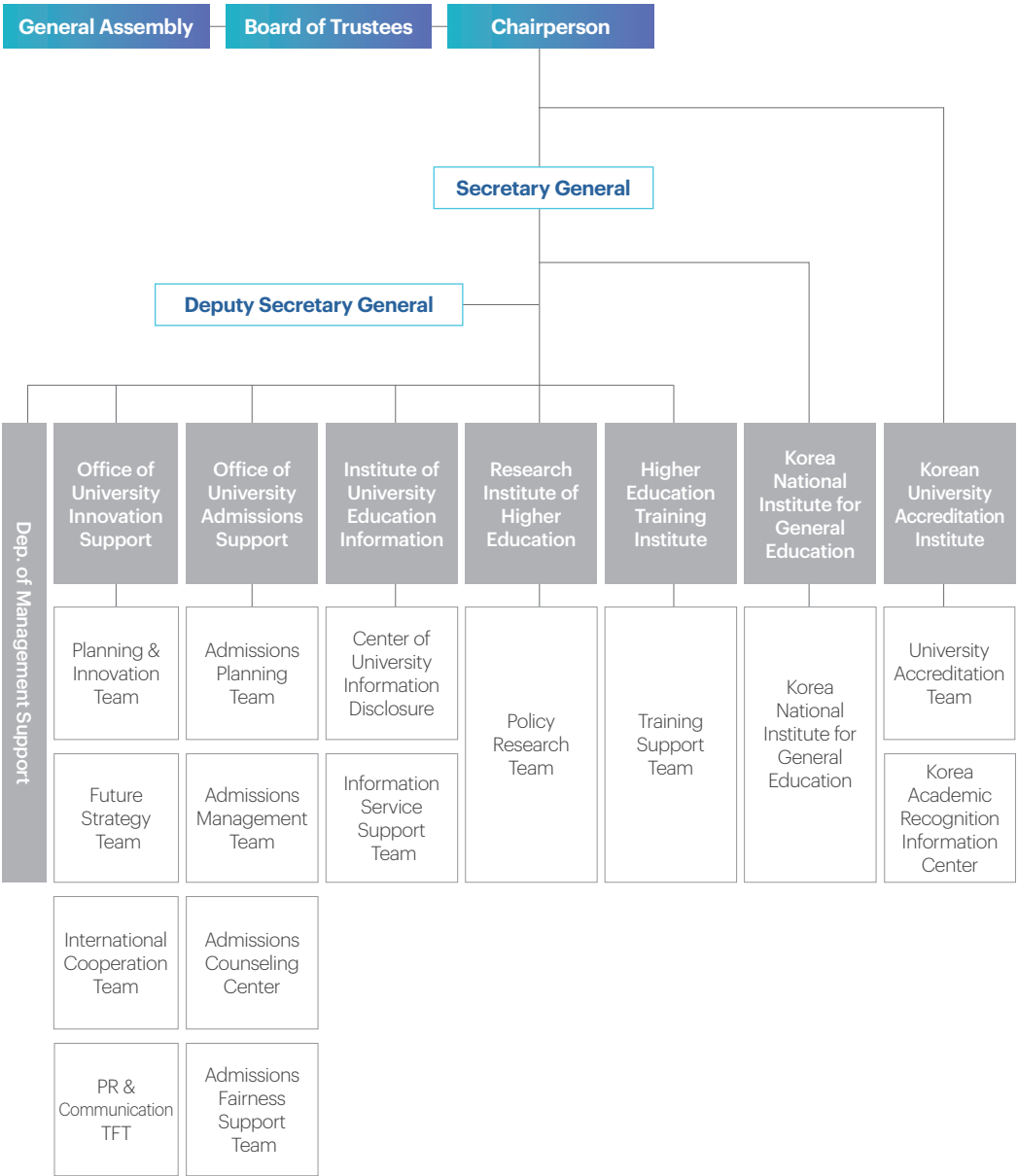

Student Selection Framework for University Admissions

OBJECTIVE

- To establish, develop, and set the Student Selection Framework for University Admissions to ensure autonomy and predictability of University admissions process by reflecting various opinions from stakeholders

Proposal of basic directions and principles for college admissions process

Bring school education back on track and curtail private education costs

Legal basis

- Article 34-5 of the Higher Education Act: Public Announcement of Plans for Selection of Applicants for Admission to University or College
- Article 32 of the Enforcement Decree of the Higher Education Act: Public Announcement of Basic Rules on Screening of Applicants for Admission to University or College, etc
- Article 33 thereof : Publication of Implementation Plans for Screening of Applicants for Admission to Universities and Colleges

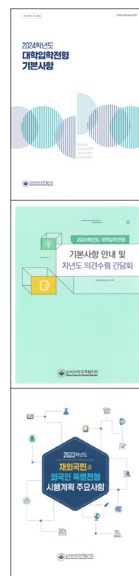
Preliminary announcement on University admissions process

- Announce basic matters concerning the selection of applicants for admission to each university or college (at least two years and six months prior to academic year)
- Formulate and publicly announce an implementation plan for the selection of applicants for admission to the university or college (at least one year and ten months prior to academic year)
- Announce 'Guidelines on University Application' (end of April for early admissions; end of August for regular admissions)

Facilitate the operations of the University admissions process and provide relevant information

- Operate the University Admissions Screening Committee for consultation / coordination concerning pending issues on college admissions
- Address the information gap on University Admissions to facilitate preparations of schools

Support Universities to Contribute to Revitalization of High School Education

OBJECTIVE

- To support admissions screening that contributes to streamlining admission screening and revitalizing high school education
- To ensure institutional autonomy and empower universities to operate admissions screening process

DESCRIPTION

- Select universities contributing to revitalizing high school education and provide financial support
- Enhance universities to implement the admission system reliably and fairly
- Improve the admission system and encourage operational capabilities
- Support education and extra curricular activities of high schools

University Admissions Fair

OBJECTIVE

- To help students, parents, teachers and counselors to obtain comprehensive and practical information on university admissions and counseling
- To create opportunities for participating universities to attract students

DESCRIPTION

- Biannual (early admissions in July, regular admissions in December)
- Individual booth for each participating university (1:1 counseling)
- Special booth dedicated to the admissions officer system and equal admissions opportunities

- To provide career counseling, university admissions information and teacher training to establish public education-oriented university admissions counseling

Project to Reinforce the Fairness of the University Entrance System

OBJECTIVE

- To facilitate aggressive support for individual universities to ensure the operation of a fair admissions policy and meet the public's expectations
- To identify and tackle improvement points to eliminate any unfair factors and ensure a fair college entrance process
- To establish a common admissions management and support system targeting all universities

PROJECT DETAIL

- Reinforcing the fairness of the college entrance system by preventing external factors (avoidance, exclusion, etc.) from exerting an impact on the system and thereby ensuring that evaluations are performed based on individual students' capacities and achievements
- Enhancing expertise in system operation by renovating relevant procedures and elevating the capabilities of admissions officers to new heights so that all applicants' submissions are evaluated fairly and thoroughly
- Improving transparency and public trust in the college entrance system through the transparent sharing of the evaluation criteria and screening results

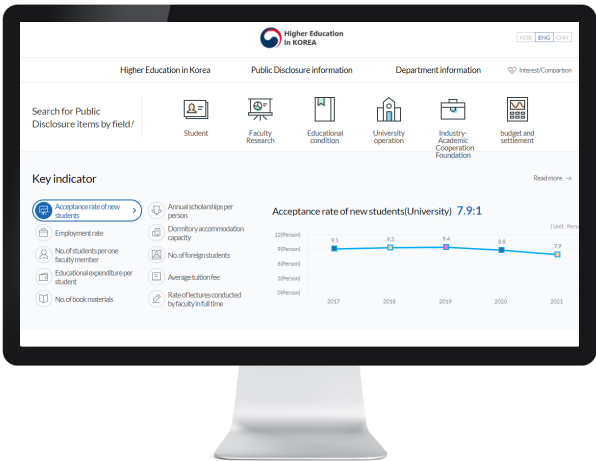

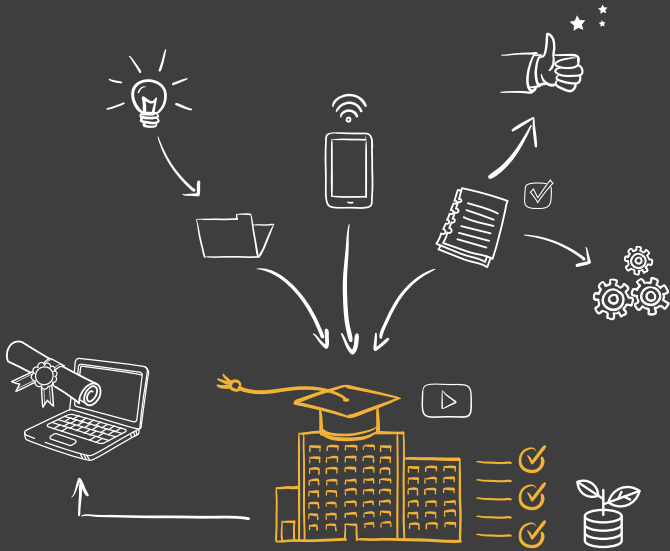


Standard Classification System

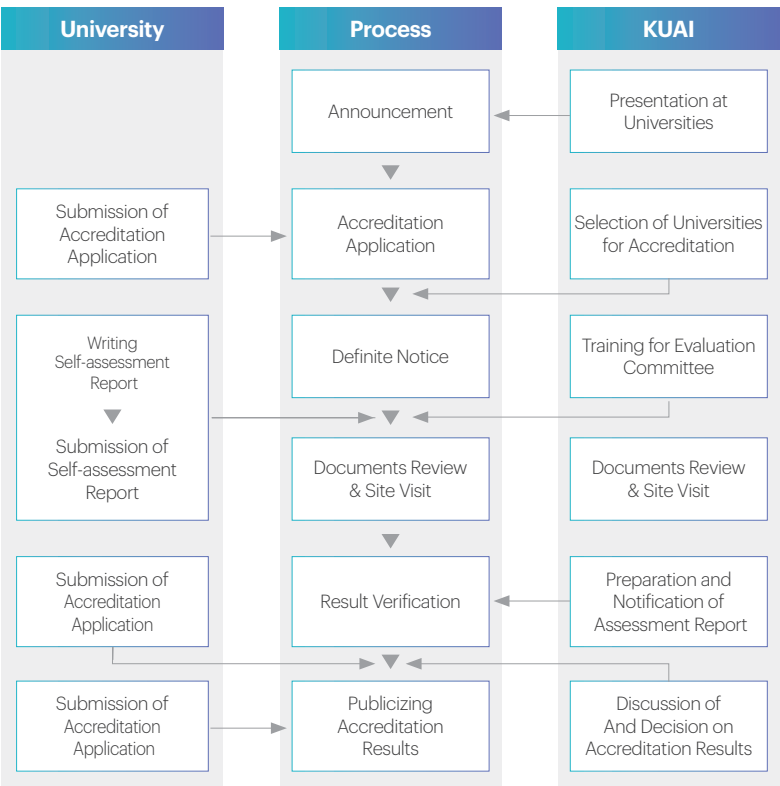

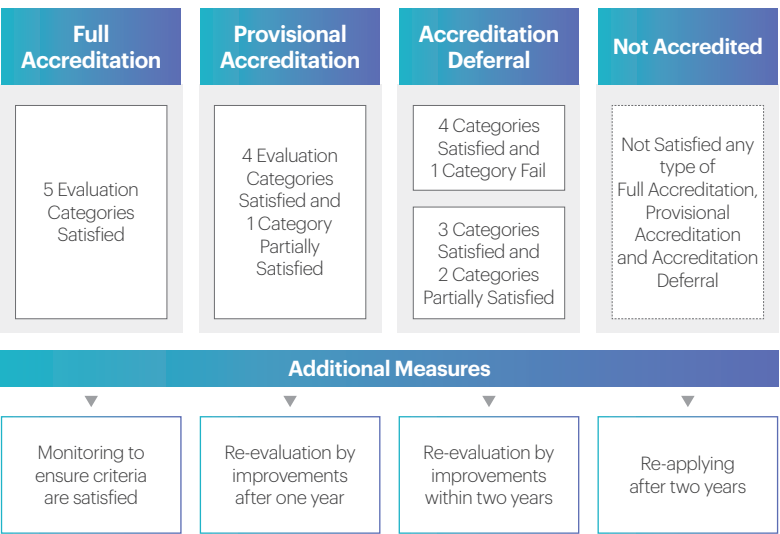
- To improve and ensure the quality of higher education by evaluating universities to verify that they fulfill standards and publicize the results for people's right to know and build social trust

ACCREDITATION PROCESS

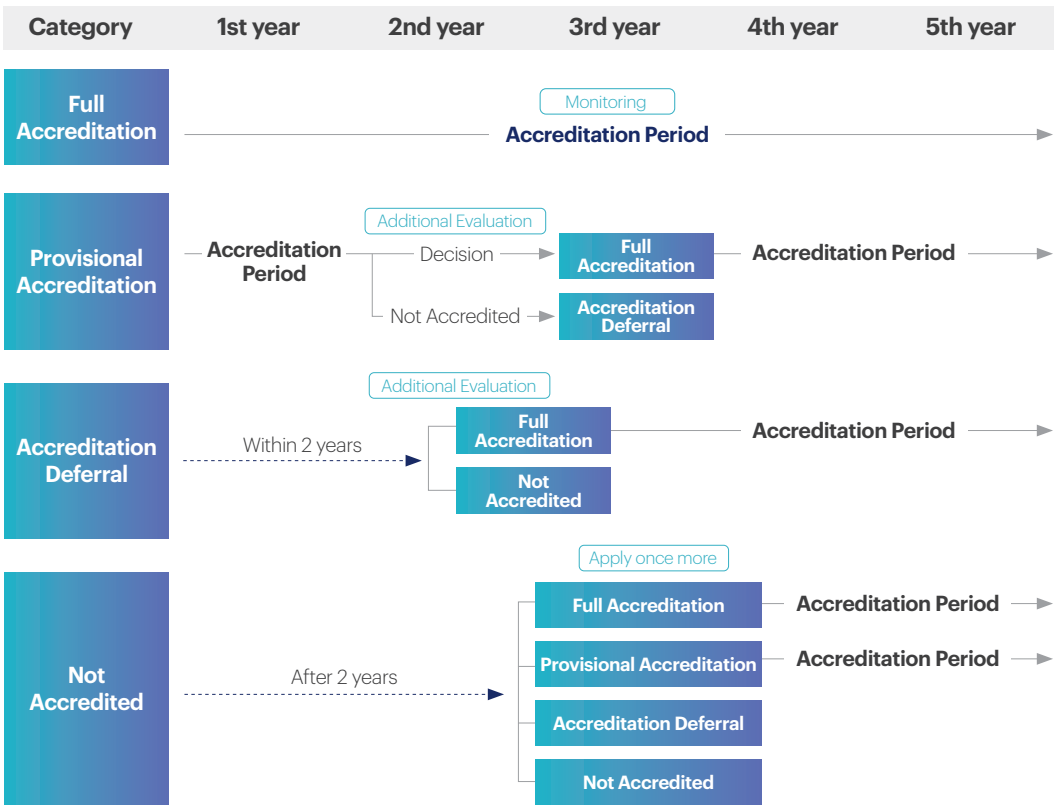


※ KUAI(Korean University Accreditation Institute) is the recognized accreditor to 4-year universities in Korea and affiliated to the Korean Council for University Education.

Quality Assurance

- AUTHORIZATION

- In Korea, establishment of a new higher education institution is only approved when the institution is expected to guarantee a certain level of quality, and authorization from the Ministry of Education should be obtained to issue higher education qualifications.
- INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION

- The Korean Council for University Education(KCUE)-affiliated Korean University Accreditation Institute(KUAI) is designated as the accreditation agency in charge of evaluation and accreditation of universities and colleges. The Korea Accreditation Board for Vocational Higher Education(KAVE), the affiliate of KCCE, is designated as the approved agency for the accreditation of Junior Colleges. The Korean Council for Online University(KCOU) is designated as the approved agency for the accreditation of Online Universities.
- PROGRAM ACCREDITATION

- Program Accreditation is designed to improve the quality of academic degrees in professional fields. The evaluations are conducted by external accreditation agencies that are recognized by the government.
 - Fields : Architecture, Dental, Health & Medical Information Management, Korean Medicine, MBA, Medical, Nursing, Pharmacy, Veterinary, Pharmacy
- INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION QUALITY ASSURANCE SYSTEM

- IEQAS (International Education Quality Assurance System) is designed to improve international education quality assurance for Korean universities. The Ministry of Education evaluates degree courses and language courses offered by universities on a yearly basis. IEQAS-accredited HEIs may recruit Global Korea Scholarship (GKS) recipients and are provided with visa incentives.
 - The period of the international education accreditation is valid for four years from the date of Accreditation.

OBJECTIVE

- Pending issues and conferences: Seeking measures to resolve shared challenges and pending issues facing universities and distributing the results to member universities, policy authorities, and relevant institutions to be used as reference material for policy development and proposals

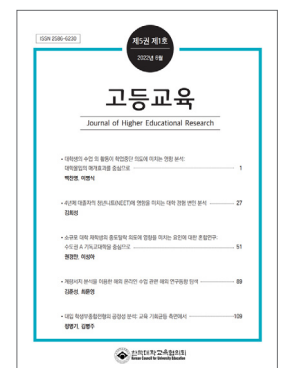

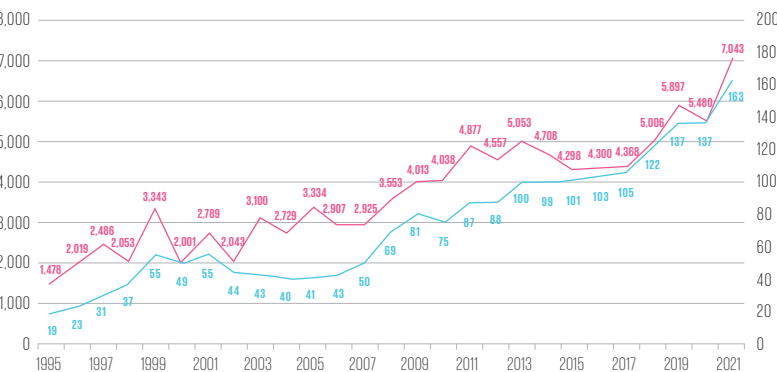

Job training	A training course for university administrative personnel to learn the theoretical and practical knowledge necessary to perform their duties and to learn efficient ways to perform and improve their duties by sharing practical experience
Practical skills training	A training course for university administrative personnel to learn practical skills necessary to efficiently operate their work, and to learn the ability to solve actual tasks through this
Specific job training	Training courses centered on work-related topics for personnel who perform specific duties (e.g., admissions officers, industry-academic cooperation foundation)

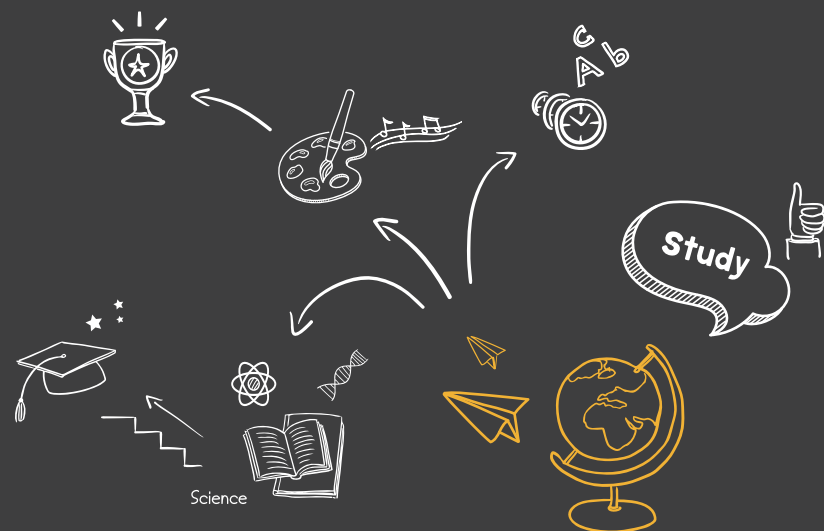

CONCEPT

- The CAMPUS Asia is a cross-border student mobility program among Korea, Japan, and China, initiated by the agreement of the Summit Meeting of Korea, Japan and China in 2010.

OBJECTIVE

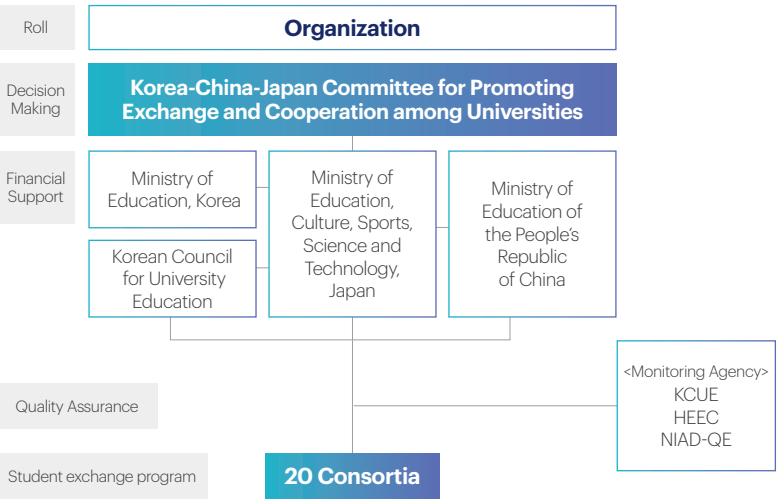
- To cultivate mutual understanding among the Korea, China and Japan and ASEAN university students, to establish an education cooperation system for international competencies, and to foster future leaders in Asia, through exchanges among universities with quality assurance with the cooperation of the respective governments and quality assurance institutions.

BACKGROUND

- 2nd Korea-China-Japan Trilateral Summit (October 2, 2009)
 - Proposed to conduct high-quality student exchanges among universities in the three countries and to hold an experts meeting to discuss promotion of exchanges
- 3rd Korea-China-Japan Trilateral Summit (May 30, 2010)
 - Agreed on implementing the CAMPUS Asia Project as a new education cooperation mechanism
 - Confirmation of the continuation of the Korea-China-Japan Committee for Promoting Exchange and Cooperation among Universities
- 3rd Meeting of the KCJ Committee for Promoting Exchange and Cooperation among Universities (May 17, 2011)
 - Finalization of Guidelines for Exchange and Cooperation among Universities in KCJ with Quality Assurance
- 7th Meeting of the KCJ Committee for Promoting Exchange and Cooperation among Universities (September 5, 2019)
 - Proposal on the Expansion Scheme of CAMPUS Asia to ASEAN in Mode 3 (FY2021-2025)
 - Confirmation on the importance of drawing up Common Standard for Qualified Program with quality assurance
- 3rd Trilateral Education Ministers Meeting (January 10, 2020)
 - Welcome to the concept of the Expansion Scheme of CAMPUS Asia

FEATURES

- Build double degree programs and a wide range of student exchange programs among Korea, Japan, and China
- Develop tailored curriculum aiming to foster talents and to deepen mutual understanding among the three countries
- Improve the quality of the program through QA monitoring
- Discuss to expand CAMPUS Asia to build a Pan-Asia exchange program, moving beyond the three countries.
- Pilot project (2012-2016, 10 consortia) & Full-fledged program (2016-2020, 17 consortia from 40 universities in 3 countries)

ACHIEVEMENT

- Reinforcing the basis for cooperation in Higher Education policies with the New Southern region, such as participating in regular meetings and councils, and continuously expanding student exchange programs within the region.
- Facilitate cooperation between ASEAN-Korea universities and support specialization through student/academic exchanges with outstanding ASEAN universities and Korea universities.
- From the start of the AIMS programme in 2016 to the second half of 2020, a total of 726 students exchanges are supported, and mutually beneficial human exchanges between Korea and ASEAN are expanded.

HIGHER EDUCATION FOR ASEAN TALENTS (HEAT)

- Objective
 - Higher Education for ASEAN Talents (HEAT) is designed to provide higher education in Korea for ASEAN faculty members. The main purpose of this program is to invite faculty members from ASEAN higher education institutions to support their acquisition of a doctoral degree in Korea with the aim to enhance their expertise and promote people-to-people exchanges between Korea and ASEAN. HEAT is funded from ASEAN-Korea Cooperation Fund(AKCF).
- Eligibility
 - ASEAN professor with a master's degree
- Benefits
 - Tuition, Round-trip Travel, Monthly Allowance, Settlement Allowance, Dissertation Printing Costs, Self-Quarantine Fee, etc.

National Information Center in Korea



WHO WE ARE

- KARIC (Korea Academic Recognition Information Center) was launched by KCUE in September, 2017 to lay the groundwork for implementing the Asia-Pacific Regional Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications in Higher Education. It is designated as a National Information Center(NIC) in 2019.

ACADEMIC RECOGNITION IN KOREA

- In Korea, the competent recognition authorities are higher education institutions or other entities, and the competence to make decisions in recognition matters lies with higher education institutions or other entities.

WHAT WE AIM TO DO

- We provide official information on Korean higher education for stakeholders both at home and abroad to enable the competent recognition authorities to ascertain whether the quality of the qualifications issued by foreign institutions justifies the recognition and to support the policy development and internationalization of Korean higher education.

ASIA-PACIFIC REGIONAL CONVENTION ON THE RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATIONS IN HIGHER EDUCATION

- The Asia-Pacific Regional Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications in Higher Education entered into force on 1st February 2018, after five countries expressed agreement to be bound by the Convention. The convention aims to encourage international collaboration and mobility, and to ensure the recognition of qualifications in higher education as widely as possible in order to promote lifelong education and the democratization of education.

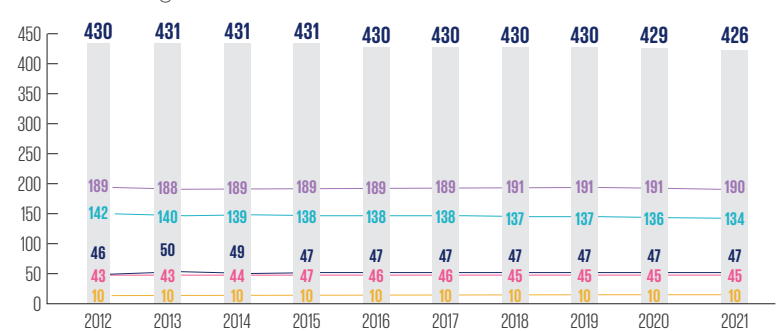

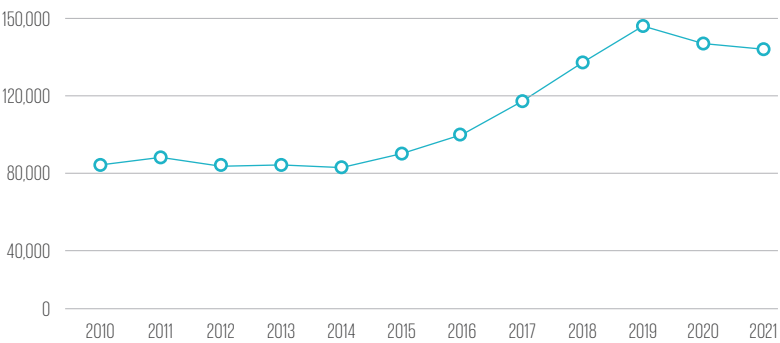

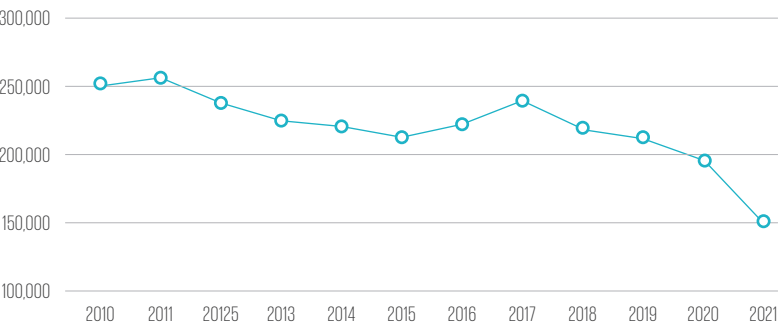
