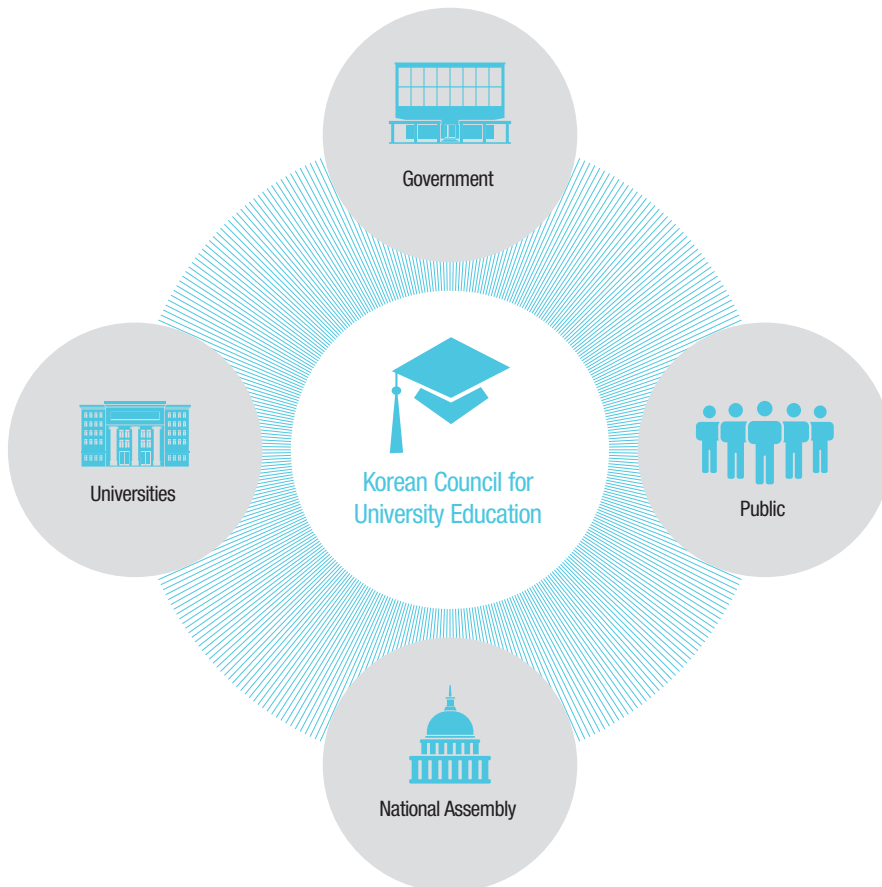

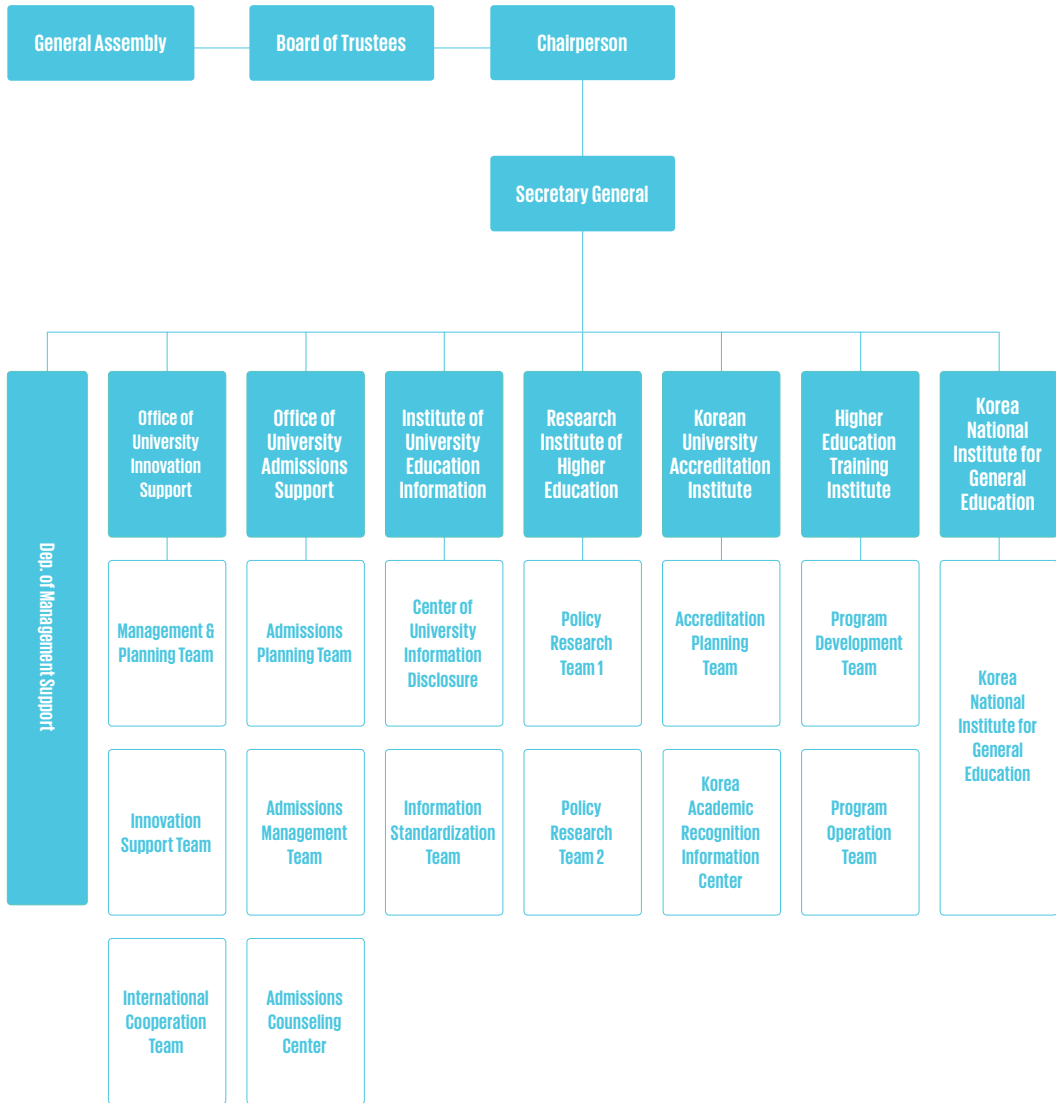

Legal basis

- Article 34-5 of the Higher Education Act: Public Announcement of Plans for Selection of Applicants for Admission to University or College
- Article 32 of the Enforcement Decree of the Higher Education Act: Public Announcement of Basic Rules on Screening of Applicants for Admission to University or College, etc
- Article 33 thereof : Publication of Implementation Plans for Screening of Applicants for Admission to Universities and Colleges

Preliminary announcement on college admissions process

- Announce basic matters concerning the selection of applicants for admission to each university or college (at least two years and six months prior to academic year)
- Formulate and publicly announce an implementation plan for the selection of applicants for admission to the university or college (at least one year and ten months prior to academic year)
- Announce 'Guidelines on University Application' (end of April for early admissions; end of August for regular admissions)

Facilitate the operations of the college admissions process and provide relevant information

- Operate the College Admissions Screening Committee for consultation / coordination concerning pending issues on college admissions
- Address the information gap on college admissions to facilitate preparations for at schools

Faculty	Matters concerning status of full-time faculty, etc.

Standard Classification System

- Each university's educational framework (division, department/major field) is organized in accordance with the Standard Classification System to ensure the comparability of information across departments and major fields, consistency in statistical information, and greater efficiency in the exchange and use of information.

Information Service on University Specializations

- Enable students to make informed decisions about higher education institutions and provide greater opportunities for businesses to recruit talented workers by providing research result that would help universities develop distinctive educational programs and raise competitiveness

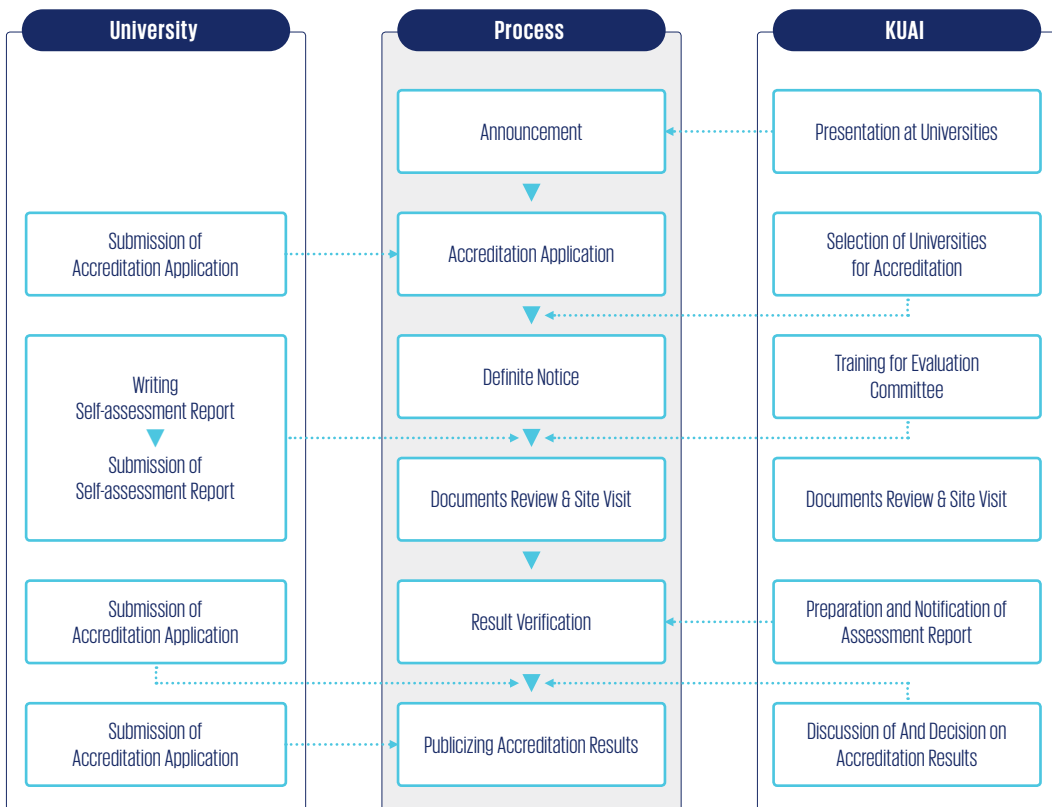

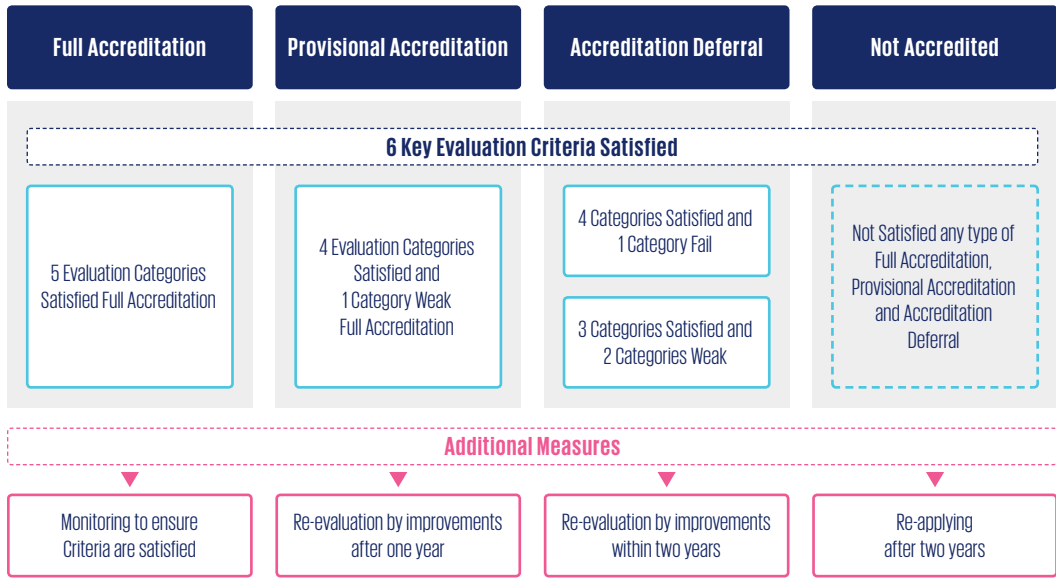

ACCREDITATION PROCESS

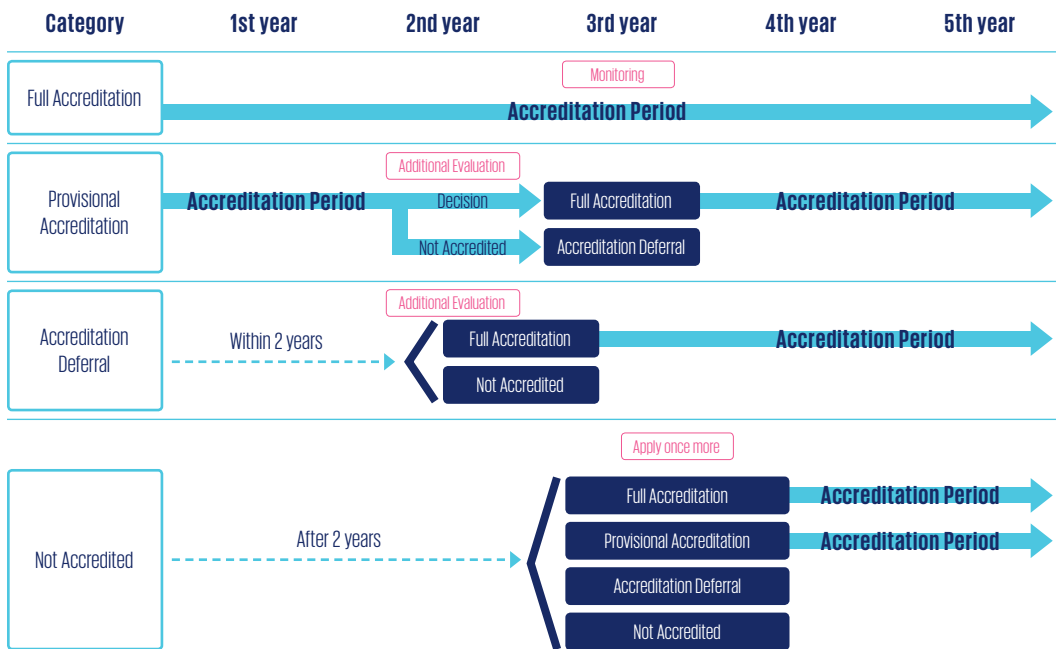

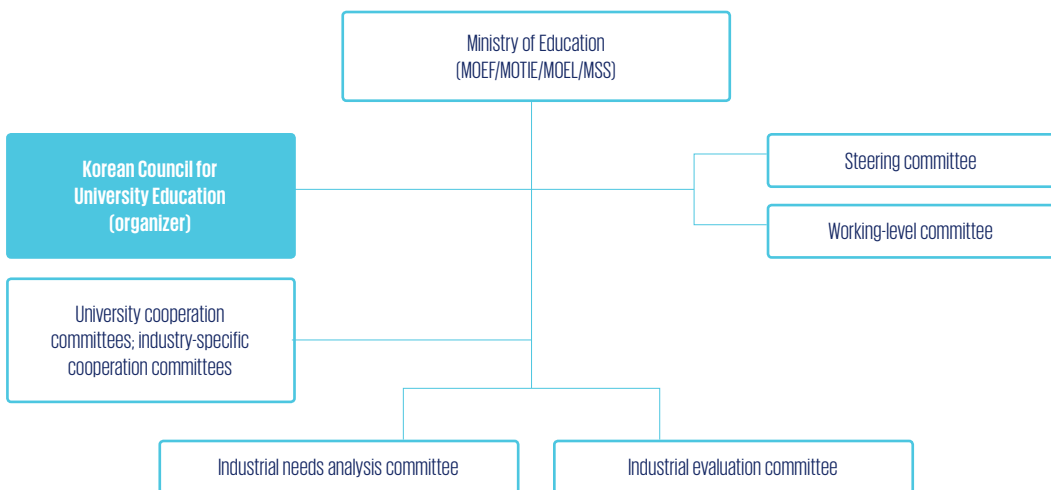


University Evaluation from Industry-Perspective

OBJECTIVE

- To promote industry-university-government communication and better leverage its outcome with the goal of improving/running university curricula for nurturing talents that meet industrial needs

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE



KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- Conduct two-track needs analysis on key industries and new/emerging sectors to meet industrial demand for new business opportunities on a timely basis in the wake of the Fourth Industrial Revolution
- Ensure curriculum-oriented evaluation so universities can actively seek curricular improvements requested by industries
- Provide consulting service tailored to universities based on needs analysis and evaluation results

MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

- Made demand analysis on 56 areas and evaluated 48 fields in 2008-2018 to help improve school curricula with a focus on student performance and capabilities
- Key publications: Comprehensive report on results from industrial evaluation of universities; comprehensive report on demand analysis results; information package on industry-university-government communication forum; information package on best practices; information package on result seminar; etc.

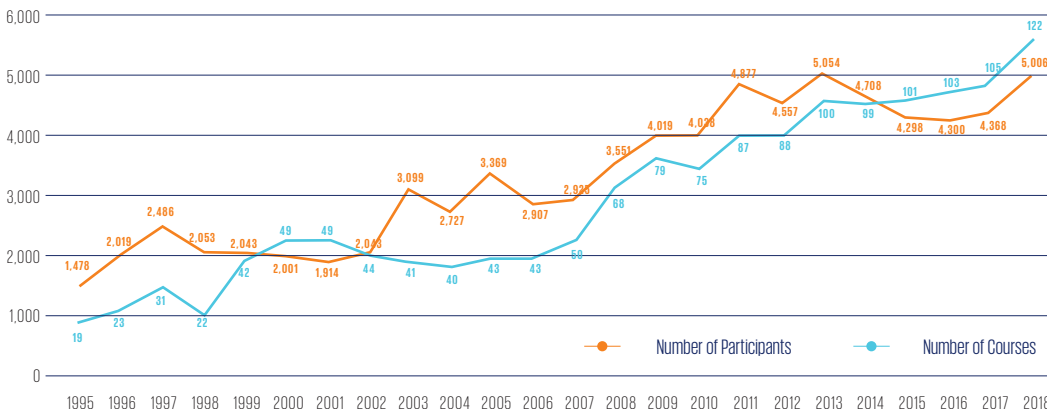

Occupational training	Learn theoretical and practical knowledge needed to perform duties in respective administrative departments; improve job performance and learn ways of increasing efficiency by sharing field experiences
Leadership position	Learn skills and competences required to manage and administer university organizations (target participants: senior staff and professors, who are responsible for management/administration of universities)
On-the-job skills	Learn practical skills and functions needed to make university administration more efficient and build competence to address common problems

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS & TRAINING COURSES



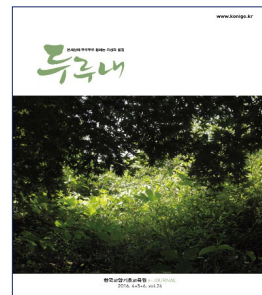

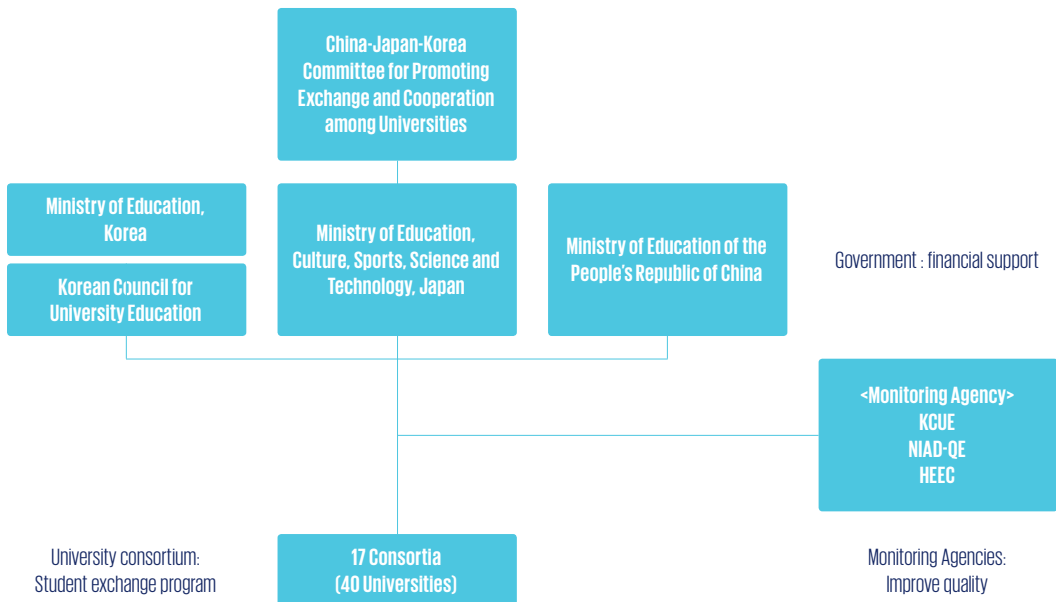
CAMPUS Asia is a cross-border student mobility program among Korea, Japan, and China, initiated by agreement of the trilateral Summit Meeting in 2010.

OBJECTIVE

- To nurture young talents and strengthen academic networks by developing double degree program and co-curricula and promoting student exchange among HEIs in East Asia

FEATURES

- Build double degree programs and a wide range of student exchange programs among Korea, Japan and China
- Develop tailored curriculum aiming to foster talents and to deepen mutual understanding among three countries
- Conduct joint monitoring to secure and improve quality of the program
- Discuss to expand CAMPUS Asia beyond the full fledged program (2016-2020)
- Pilot project (2012-2016, 10 consortia) & Full-fledged program (2016-2020, 17 consortia)

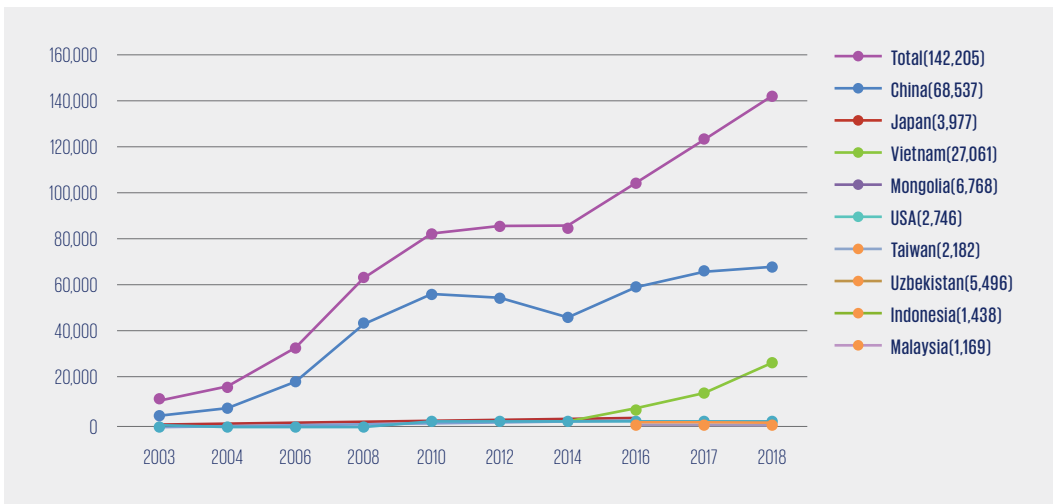

ATTRACTION OF FOREIGN STUDENTS - STUDY IN KOREA 2023

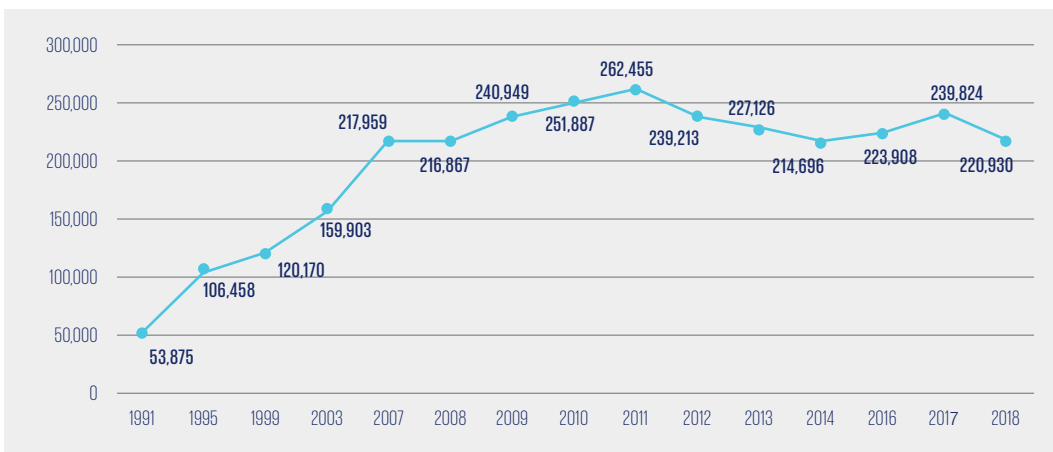

Quality Assurance

- The quality of Korean higher education is guaranteed by various measures. In Korea, establishment of a new higher education institution is only approved when the institution is expected to guarantee a certain level of quality, and authorization from the Minister of Education should be obtained to issue higher education qualifications.
- To maintain and improve the quality of HEIs, several types of quality assurance measures are adopted. Firstly, HEIs should conduct a self-inspection and evaluation and publicly announce their findings. Accreditation is a representative tool for quality assurance in Korea. HEIs are encouraged to achieve accreditation. This process is voluntary, however, and not mandatory. All competent accreditation authorities are required to apply for and gain recognition from the Ministry of Education(MOE) to conduct accreditation.

Establishment of Universities

- Any person who intends to establish a school shall meet the conditions for establishing facilities, equipment, etc. prescribed by Presidential Decree. Establishment of a school by any party other than the State requires authorization from the Minister of Education. In addition, where any founder or operator of a public or private school intends to abolish the school or modify important matters prescribed by Presidential Decree, he/she shall obtain authorization from the Minister of Education.

Evaluation & Accreditation

INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION

- The Korean Council for University Education (KCUE), a 4-year university association founded in 1982, is responsible for the accreditation of four-year universities. The Korean Council for University Education(KCUE)-affiliated Korean University Accreditation Institute(KUAI) is designated as the recognized accreditor.
- The Korean Council for College Education (KCCE) is an association of junior colleges and responsible for their institutional accreditation. The Korea Accreditation Board for Vocational Higher Education(KAVE), an affiliate of KCCE, is designated as the approved agency for the accreditation of all junior colleges.

PROGRAM ACCREDITATION

- Program Accreditation is designed to improve the quality of academic degrees in professional fields. The evaluations are conducted by external accreditation agencies that are recognized by the government.
- Field : Engineering, Nursing, Architecture, Business, Medicine, Dental, Oriental Medicine

International Education Accreditation

- IEQAS (International Education Quality Assurance System) is designed to improve international education quality assurance for Korean universities. The Ministry of Education evaluates degree courses offered by universities on a yearly basis. IEQAS-accredited HEIs may recruit Global Korea Scholarship (GKS)* recipients and are provided with visa incentives.

*GKS is a scholarship program that is supported by the Korean government.
